#### **CUB SCOUT LEADER OF THE YEAR:**

This is a local District award. Nomination consists of completing the nomination form and submitting to the District Awards & Recognition Committee. The nomination should detail the outstanding accomplishments of the nominated leader during the previous year.

#### **SCOUTS BSA LEADER OF THE YEAR:**

This is a local District award. Nomination consists of completing the nomination form and submitting to the District Awards & Recognition Committee. The nomination should detail the outstanding accomplishments of the Scout leader during the previous year.

#### **VENTURE CREW LEADER OF THE YEAR:**

This is a local District award. Nomination consists of completing the nomination form and submitting to the District Awards & Recognition Committee. The nomination should detail the outstanding accomplishments of the Leader during the previous year.

#### **SEA SCOUT / EXPLORER POST LEADER OF THE YEAR:**

This is a local District award. Nomination consists of completing the nomination form and submitting to the District Awards & Recognition Committee. The nomination should detail the outstanding accomplishments of the Leader during the previous year.

#### **LIGHTHOUSE AWARD:**

This is a local District award. Nomination consists of completing the nomination form and submitting to the District Awards & Recognition Committee. The recipient may be any adult volunteer in the Coastal District who has served as a "shining" example of the principles of scouting, through their exemplary support of the BSA program.
