The Bay Area Council has transitioned back to **council-held** in-person gatherings and activities.

We have developed and are using a Risk Mitigation Plan (Safety Plan) for each activity to ensure we are including appropriate safety measures centered around wearing masks, social distancing and hand sanitizing as needed, when handwashing is not readily available. (This is required to attend any programming on council property.)
